



# ON THE BIT Combined Test May 19<sup>th</sup> 2018

This event is suitable for all ages of rider and green to experienced horses. A traditional combined test is offered, or one may do as many dressage tests or jumping rounds as desired. Mix it up or stay with one discipline. Ride times for all disciplines will be assigned after the closing date. Combined tests are \$40. Dressage tests and jumping rounds are \$20 each. Blue ribbon rounds are \$10.

## Combined Tests

- 1) Modified Riding Combined Test – Modified Dressage Pattern/Ground Rails (\$20)
- 2) Green as Grass Combined Test – Walk/Trot Test B/Jumps max 18”
- 3) Starter Combined Test – Beg Novice Test A/ Max Jumps 2’3”
- 4) Beginner Novice Combined Test – Beg Novice Test B/Max Jumps 2’7”
- 5) Novice Combined Test – Novice Test A/Max Jumps 3’
- 6) Training Combined Test – Training Test A/Max Jumps 3’3”
- 7) Preliminary Combined Test – Preliminary Test A/Max Jumps 3’7”

## Jumping

Blue Ribbon rounds: All jumping heights offer a “blue ribbon” round (BR). One BR round per rider per height. Blue ribbons are awarded to all clear rounds. BR Rounds are not timed and placings are not awarded. “A” classes: Competitors with the least amount of jumping faults and closest to optimum time wins. “B” classes: Competitors with zero jumping faults will move onto the jump off round (stay in arena). Least jumping faults and closest to optimum time wins.

**Ride times:** Ride times will be placed on the Silver Snaffles Website <https://silversnafflesponyclub.weebly.com/> and FB page. Check in with show office upon arrival.

**Apparel:** ASTM/SEI helmets are required when mounted. Show attire is encouraged but not required. Neat polo shirt, breeches, and boots or paddocks with boot like half chaps is acceptable. Rider/horse numbers required while mounted.

**Longeing:** in designated areas only. Schooling/Hacking allowed in warm up areas only.

**Arenas:** All outside. Jumper classes and warm up in a fenced grass arena. Dressage warm up on grass, CT dressage and 101-103 classes in a 20 x 40 sand mix arena, all others in 20 x 60.

**Stabling:** Permanent stalls are available for \$25. Move in from 5 pm Friday. Assigned stalls, please check with show office on move in. Stabling requests permitted. If not using stalls, there is a \$15 trailer in fee per horse. Coggins test required for all horses.

**Awards:** Jumper, Dressage, and Combined Training classes will be placed through 6<sup>th</sup>. Combined test entries will receive ribbons for each round/test entered as well as a ribbon for combined test placement.

**Substitutions:** Substitutions will be allowed for a horse **OR** a rider in the same class. **A \$10 change fee will apply.** Any other changes will be considered a new entry and will be accepted or not as time allows.

**Refunds:** Refunds given, minus a \$10 processing fee, if requested in writing (email) prior to closing date. No refunds after the closing date without a veterinarian certificate. Vet certificate must be received within two days of the show to qualify for the refund minus \$10 processing.
